Now that we have beautiful new landscaping (thanks to the generosity of one of our long time patrons), we decided to do a little more sprucing up. So we painted the nose of the stairs for better visibility and started looking at better lighting.

In the end, we decided to install a commercial lamppost that will come on at dusk. The fixture utilizes long-life LEDs that will last 100,000 hours and only consumes 30 watts, which should get us to our 75th anniversary and only cost \$250 in total to operate! Installation will be in the next few weeks.
