The Driftwood Theatre was selected by the Roberts' family to benefit from the sale of this wine. All of Westport Winery's vintages have a selected local charity to benefit from their sale. Since theatre is fantasy, this wine's label embraces the spirit of the surreal. The winery's signature lighthouse, drawn by Bob McCausland, rests in ruin on the ocean floor while a bubble filled with dolphins (representing the sparkling nature of the wine) floats in front of a passing shark. The underwater shark image is one shot by winery owner Blain Roberts when he owned Lahaina Divers, Hawaii's largest charter scuba diving business. The wine's back label says, "Divers call it nitrogen narcosis. Oh how those little bubbles change everything. Fortunately, our cran-boggling bubbly doesn't negatively affect your central nervous system. In fact, you can forget nerves all together as you relax and drink to the mysteries of the deep blue sea. This is your celebration." After the Driftwood Theatre event this wine is available for tasting for the public at the winery. Wine club members will enjoy early tasting of this wine when they visit the winery this week. Members of Driftwood Theatre assisted in bottling the wine on Saturday.
