Larry Tingwall got involved with Driftwood when his wife Margaret was cast as the lead in the play *Angel Street* in 1989. He went to the theatre to watch the dress rehearsal and the director, Janice Wolfe, asked him if he would stand in for a small non-speaking part just for that rehearsal. When he returned home that evening, Janice called and begged him to do the part, as the person who was originally cast was unable to do it. After doing the part he decided acting was not for him, but saw that the theatre needed lots of little things fixed, and spent the next few weeks fixing whatever was needed. Then in Sept. 1989, Jane Mezera asked him to run the lights for the season opener *Social Security*. Larry didn't know much about theatre lighting but was a fast learner and was soon elected to the Driftwood Board as the lights and sound trustee, a position he still holds today. Larry has run the lights and/or sound for every production since and the production *Run for Your Wife* was his 108th. In 2006, Larry added the website to his duties and keeps the site up-to-date with current show information, and has also posted pictures of approximately 170 of our past plays. Last year he added a Driftwood page on Facebook because, it seems, everybody has a Facebook page.
